"Dreaming big, I am hoping to get into the program, form connections with others who believe in empowering the next generation and become a success story to show how we ourselves are responsible for unlocking our future today."

Canning Mayor Patrick Hall said the Business Mentoring Program was developed to provide advice and guidance for local businesses on their journey to bigger and better things.

"We recognise that running a business can often be a lonely journey and having the advice and support of a mentor is invaluable," he said.
